2496 Hours Reminder & Update

As of February 27, 2008, the calculation for maximum allowable hours (the 2496 hours) is

January 1, 2009 to December 31, 2009.

Due to the downturn in work there will be no exceptions made in the 2496 rule this year. Anyone exceeding 2496 hours for 2009 will be charged according to the motion passed January 20, 1999

*M/S/C that Members or Casuals be allowed to work **a maximum** of "2496" hours in a contract year providing they take their required Vacation Entitlement. This shall include all hours: ILWU/BCMEA, Marco/ILWU, Training, Union Business, future jurisdiction and T&T hours.*

This rule will be strictly enforced.
