## **IN SUPPORT OF 600 ILWU LOCAL 30 WORKERS LOCKED OUT BY RIO TINTO**

At 7:00 am on January 31, 2010, the Rio Tinto corporation locked out nearly 600 ILWU members at their Borax mine and plant in Boron, CA.

Rio Tinto is a foreign-owned, mega mining conglomerate that's trying to force a concessionary contract ultimatum onto working families and communities in California's High Desert.

**ILWU Members, Casuals & Friends on the Pacific west coast are encouraged to rally simultaneously outside of their local British Consulates in support of the affected ILWU Local 30 workers.**
