ELECTION PROTOCOL

To make this election as fair and transparent as possible, the following points **must** be followed:

1. Bulletins are not to be defaced or torn down (use your power at the ballot box);
2. No offensive or demeaning material to be posted (anyone has the right to run for office);
3. All election material (posted or not) must be signed by the individual or group (all members) producing the material;
4. A list of nominees will be available to View at the Union Office as nominations are submitted. An official list will be presented at close of nominations and after nominees are checked as per ILWU, Local 500 Election Criteria. The Union Office Staff is authorized by the Elections Officer to place nominees on the respective list and place the nomination form into the locked ballot box while the nominee watches.
