RE: PORT ACCESS GATES – UPDATE – Wednesday, March 23, 2011.

Port Metro Vancouver is committed to increasing the efficiency of traffic flow at the Port. We continue to work with Port road users to assist us in making improvements to the fluidity of traffic. The closure of Clark Drive as an entrance has been a successful trial. Congestion on city streets related to traffic flows destined for the Port has been reduced to a minimum.

During the past 12 weeks, we have received various comments pertaining to the closure of Clark Drive as an entrance as we continue to look for opportunities to improve the overall traffic flow. We continue to dialogue with the City regarding traffic lights and turn lanes in an effort to enhance exiting at Clark Drive.

Therefore, please be advised of the following **interim** change, effective **Wednesday, March 23, 2011:**

**Clark Drive (Inbound) Access Gate will
reopen to passenger vehicles with:**

- **a maximum height of 6 feet, 8 inches,
and**
- **carry at least one passenger with a valid
Port Pass**
